Through this fund those individuals will be able to get help and learn about horsemanship from horsemen who have dedicated their lives to helping such people and their horse.

The Luminere Scholarship fund will also promote the future of the horse industry by supporting dedicated individuals who will give back to their community the knowledge they were given.

## Application Process (Deviation from this process will result in disqualification.):

1. Applicants will complete the attached application and mail to:
  - i. Stock Horse of Wisconsin
  - ii. Attn: Luminere Scholarship Fund
  - iii. P.O. Box 866
  - iv. Sturgeon Bay, WI 54235
2. All applications must be postmarked no later than **March 31, 2012**.
3. Applications will proceed to a six-person committee where they will be anonymously evaluated based on predetermined criteria. If the committee determines that the applicant be awarded a scholarship, an amount will be determined.
4. Applicants will be notified via mail of acceptance or denial of the scholarship application.
5. Recipients are expected to write a follow-up Reflection to the scholarship committee noting the value of the experience for you and your horse.
6. The Luminere Scholarship Fund is a formal application process; neatness and grammar are valued.
7. All scholarships are non-transferable; specific to person and event requested in application.
8. Stock Horse of Wisconsin does not discriminate, and all applications will be considered.
9. Hardship Clause: When a scholarship recipient cannot participate in their chosen event due to personal, or family crisis of any kind, their scholarship may be transferred and applied to another event of their choosing. They would need to contact the person's email or phone number given in item 10 to gain approval of the transfer.
